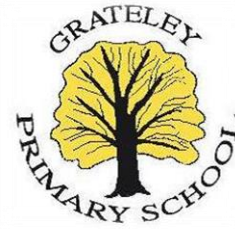

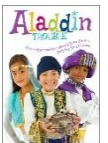
I would like to take this opportunity to say thank you to all the hard working staff at Grateley. The school simply wouldn't function without their motivation and tireless commitment to the children of our school.
