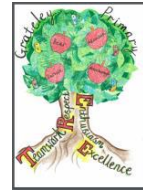




Remote Learning – September 2020



This document has been created to clearly outline the expectations of remote learning if a child, bubble, whole school, local or National lockdown should occur.

The class teachers will set work and as school is compulsory from September 2020 the expectation is that work should be completed at home and sent into the class teacher by 3pm the day it is set, unless the child is ill. This work needs to be sent in using **Purple Mash 2email (Year R to use EvidenceMe)** and not directly to the school email address. **Only 1 email per child per day which includes all attachments.** The attachments can either be work completed on the computer or scanned/photographed work that has been completed on paper. If work is completed on My Maths then it will automatically be submitted and does not need to be sent as an attachment. However, please include in the 2email message that work has been completed on My Maths so the teacher can check it.

We will continue to use multiple platforms as all children (and adults) learn in different ways and it is important children have some choice and responsibility with their learning. We will therefore set out multiple learning options for each day and week and expect parents to guide their children in choosing which way they like to learn best. Please find below the different options for lessons and activities.

1) Oak National Academy Lessons

These are DfE approved lessons provided by teachers with over 180 lessons a week from Year R to Year 10. The lessons each consist of a quiz, video and follow on activities for Maths, English and Foundation subjects. The link to use is:

2) Purple Mash (not for Year R)

This is an online learning platform where teachers will set daily activities for Maths, English and Foundation subjects. This is also the platform in which children can message their teacher through 2email about the activities and send in their completed work as attachments by 3pm each day. 3) Grateley Primary School Website

As well as the lessons available from the options above the teachers will put up a daily English and Maths challenge. There is a Home Learning page for each year group. 4) My Maths (not for Year R)

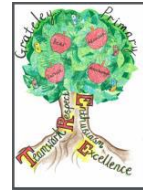
The teachers will set tasks for the children to complete on My Maths each day. The teacher can then see their results and use this when setting future tasks and in longer term planning for when the children return to school. 5) 2simple / EvidenceMe (Only for Year R)

Miss Knights will use the 2simple software, so please take photos and write notes about your child so evidence is gathered, this is instead of using Purple Mash for Year R. She will also set activities via video link for the children to complete and these will be uploaded on EvidenceMe.

Expectations

Teachers

- Set work for children working at home – Purple Mash (not Year R), My Maths (not Year R), School Website, EvidenceMe (only Year R)
- Receive work as attachments on 2email via Purple Mash (EvidenceMe for Year R)
- Respond to work with written feedback outlining achievements and a target going forward if relevant (following schools positive marking policy)
- Plan subsequent work based on progress

Children individually self-isolating or shielding

- Teachers will send out work via ParentMail by 9am
- Work to be completed and sent back via 2email using Purple Mash by 3pm that day (EvidenceMe for Year R)
- Work will be responded to via 2email or EvidenceMe with a written response

Bubble or group self-isolating

- Teachers will put up work on the website under the class page and year group
- Work to be completed and sent back via 2email using Purple Mash by 3pm that day (EvidenceMe for Year R)
- Work will be responded to via 2email or EvidenceMe with a written response

Localised or National Lockdown of the whole school

- Teachers will put up work on the website under the class page and year group
- Work to be completed and sent back via 2email using Purple Mash by 3pm that day (EvidenceMe for Year R)
- Work will be responded to via 2email or EvidenceMe with a written response

ACTION PLAN 2020-2021
