Child Friendly Positive Behaviour Policy

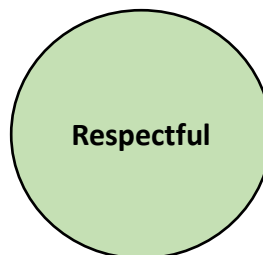

At Grateley Primary School, we have high expectations of behaviour and pupils, parents, staff and governors work together to ensure that we maintain these high standards.

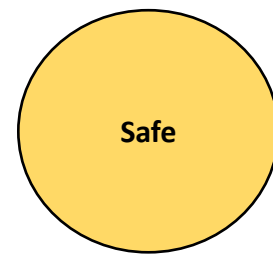
At Grateley, we all follow the same three rules:



listening
focussed
trying our best
persevering



doing as we are asked
being polite
sharing with each other
being kind



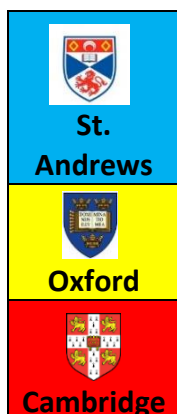
walking sensibly
playing sensibly
sharing any concerns
with a trusted adult

These simple rules help to keep us safe and make sure that our time at school is happy and fun!

Grateley is a Dojo school! When we work hard and follow the school rules in lessons we receive Dojo points. When we reach each Dojo milestone we get a certificate to take home. When we have reached our 1,000 Dojo milestone, Mrs Dance (our Head teacher) writes us a postcard and posts it to our house!



In our classrooms we have recognition boards which remind us of the school rules and how to make positive choices throughout the day. If we don't follow the school rules or we are making negative choices, our teacher holds restorative conversations with us to remind us about our behaviour. We use these conversation to have time to think about our actions and make better choices in the future. If we continue to make the same negative choices, we may have to visit Mrs Dance's office where she works with us to help us to turn our behaviour around.



All the children at Grateley Primary School are part of a house team. We named these house teams after famous universities. When we follow the school rules outside of the classroom we earn house points. At the end of each week, the house team with the most points gets recognised in celebration assembly. We also use the house system to help us with sports day and other events in school. If you want to know more about house teams you could ask Attenborough house captains about them.
