Have a super half term and I look forward to seeing you on Monday 24th February.

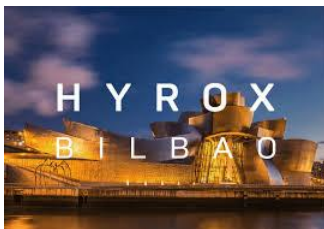

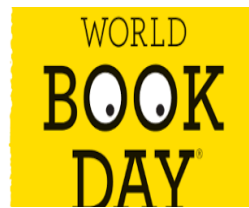
Student Leadership Team Library Assistants

World Book Day

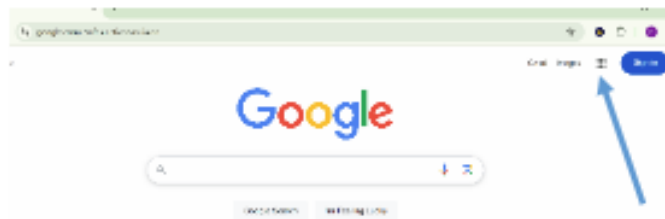


World Book takes place on Thursday 6th March. The children can come into school dressed as a character from a book.

The Library Assistants will also plan some World Book Day activities over the week for the children to participate with at lunchtimes.

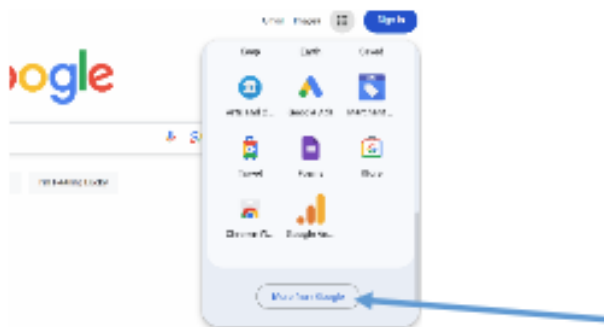
Type 'Google.com' into the web browser. In the top right hand corner there are nine dots forming a square. Click on this.
